We celebrated a great milestone in the history of Cross Road Retirement Community on Saturday, October 20, 2018 for our 35th Anniversary. We had a good number of visitors along with our residents, family members, and staff that enjoyed a “Country Hoedown” with a BBQ lunch, square dancers, and more. Our first resident was admitted on October 17, 1983 and at that time the main assisted living building was the only building on campus. I joined Cross Road as Executive Director in September, 1986 and served for 21 years and 4 months before leaving for other opportunities. I returned in August, 2015 and have now served this ministry for nearly 25 years. I am thankful for the growth and progress made over those years and look forward to seeing new progress over the next few years. The Courier-Tribune did a nice article in the paper regarding our 35th Anniversary and the Asheboro Magazine provided a feature article that provided a lot of information & photos about our 35th Anniversary. Currently our highest demand for services is for more independent living accommodations with a good number of people on our waiting list.
