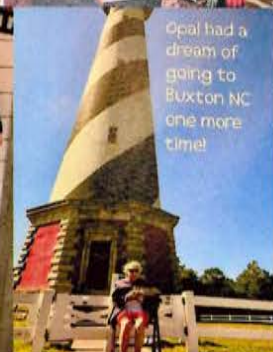
You're Never too Old for Dreams to Come True!!!
